Ordered that the western shore Treasurer Pay to William Middleton
twenty Pounds per art paid by the Rmt S^t to the Adm Gen^d and also
Forty Pounds to be delivered over to Capt John Pitt per art paid by Adm

That the said Treasurer Pay to Capt Alexander Anderson Three
hundred and Thirty nine Pounds, seventeen Shillings and seven Pence
Balance of art paid by the Adm Gen^d.

That the said Treasurer Pay to Joseph Cowman Inn^t eighty
two Pounds ten Shillings per art paid by the Adm Gen^d.

That the said Treasurer Pay to Nathaniel Potter Esquire
four hundred and seventy seven Pounds, seventeen Shillings and ten
Pence, four hundred and sixty two Pounds nine Shillings and nine
Pence due himself for the Purchase of Provisions and the further sum
of four Pounds ten Shillings for the use of James Lawrence as per
acts paid by the Adm Gen^d.

That the said Treasurer Pay to Henry Lugh & Massy ninety
four Pounds, eleven Shillings and four Pence for Wages due himself and
the crew of the Amelia per art paid by the Adm Gen^d.

That the said Treasurer Pay to Nathaniel Potter Esq^r one
thousand thirty five Pounds and four Pence to enable him to Pay the
additional Price on the Provisions Purchased for the Continent in
Caroline County as regulated by the Governor and Comit of which
act to be rendered.

Sir, We shall be obliged to you to endeavour to sell the Ship Defence
