Saturday 8 August 1770

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Callahan two hundred and sixty three Pounds five shillings per Act passed by the A. G.

That the said Treasurer pay to Gilbert Middleton twenty eight Pounds, one shilling and six pence and his party of Militia for guarding Prisoners to Philadelphia per Act passed by the Primi. C. to the A. G.

Commission of Letter of Marque & Reprisal issued to Salisbury Blackmer Master of the Schooner Widow Wadman, mounting four Cannage Guns, two Howitzers and one Swivel navigated by fourteen men seventy one Tons burthen belonging to David Stewart of Baltimore

Tuesday 11 August 1770

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to George Davey three Pounds, five shillings per Act passed by the Primi. C. to the A. G.

Wednesday 12 August 1770

Present as on Yesterday

George Digges a Native of this State who hath been absent therefrom in great Britain, and other Parts, beyond the Seas for about three years last past and hath lately that is to say within three Months now last past returned into this State appeared before the Governor and Council and before them did take repeat and subscribe the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State contained in the Act entitled an Act to Punish certain Crimes and Misdemeanors and to Prevent the Growth of Joyism

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Bryan one hundred and fifty one Pounds, two shillings and six Pence due himself and Hands of the Boat Dolphin per Account passed by the A. G.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Matthews seventy two Pounds per Act passed by the A. G.
