

Commission of Letter of Marque and Reprisal to Robert Caulfield Master of
the Brig ^a Burling mounting fourteen carriage guns from Swivels and eight small
arms & navigated by fifty men 70 Tons burthen belonging to John Sturte,
Daniel Bowley and others of Baltimore

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer Pay to James Hindman
two hundred and fourteen Pounds, twelve Shillings and one Penny and also the
further sum of Twenty Pounds per aits passed by the Prod & to the Agt.
