

Commission of Letter of Marque and Reprisal to Robert Faulfield Master of the Brig Burling, mounting fourteen carriage guns four Swivels and eight small arms & navigated by fifty men 70 Tons burthen belonging to John Street, Daniel Bowley and others of Baltimore

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer Pay to James Hindman two hundred and fourteen pounds, twelve Shillings and one Penny and also the further Sum of Twenty pounds per Act passed by the Privy C. to the alg.

Wednesday 19th August 1770.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer Pay to Col. William Richardson Nine Pounds to be delivered over to Nathaniel Potter on A/c for the additional Price of Provisions

That the said Treasurer Pay to Col. John A Stone one hundred and Eighty Dollars on A/c to be charged to the first Regiment

Friday 21 August 1770

Present as on yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer Pay to Commodore Thos^s Graison fifty Pounds on Account

Ordered that the Clerk of Baltimore County issue Capias against Daniel Doshon late of said County ^{Mariner} to answer into the State of Maryland in a Plea of Trespass upon the Law respecting the Sloop Molly

Tuesday 25 August 1770

Present as on Friday Tho^s Sim Lee Esq. attended

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer Pay to Commodore Graison Twenty eight Pounds, four Shillings and five Pence for the use of Joseph Middleton and the further Sum of Twenty seven pounds ten Shillings for the use of James Little per Acts passed by the Privy C. to the Alg.

That the said Treasurer Pay to Robert Reith, eight Pounds five Shillings and Eight Pence for 1 Month Attend^{ce} as Messenger to the Governor and Council from the 23^d July last.

That the said Treasurer Pay to John Wastneys fifteen hundred Pounds for the use of Step. Steward on A/c.
