eight shillings and four pence for the use of Captain Christ. Stull and his £  
Twenty seven pounds, thirteen shillings for the use of Capt. Grawe Thirty five  
pounds, and six pence, for the use of William Rice and seven pounds, twelve  
shillings for the use of Edward Salmon per Accounts passed by the Adm' Genl

That the said Treasurer pay to John Lysall twenty five pounds  
fourteen shillings for the use of Com<sup>r</sup> Sloper Jnr per Acc't passed by Adm'

(Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September 1770.
