Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Elis Vallett Fifty Pounds per Account passed by the Aud. Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Major Ebene Hall, Thirteen Pounds fifteen shillings, Three hundred and fourteen Pounds, fifteen shillings and nine pence due himself & sundries nineteen pounds ten shillings for the use of Thomas Coulson and the further Sum of Thirteen Pounds fifteen shillings for the use of John Hartshorn per Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud. G<sup>l</sup>.

Friday 11 September 1770

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Robert Little Thirteen Pounds ten shillings per Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Thomas Beall five hundred and sixteen pounds, seven shillings and six pence to be expended in the purchase of Blankets for the use of Col. Rawlings's Regiment to be charged to the Continent

That the said Treasurer pay to Col. Francis Ware, eight hundred and seventy seven pounds, eight shillings and four pence and forty four Pounds, ten shillings and ten pence per Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud Genl. and the further Sum of Eighty two pounds, six shillings per Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Principal & to the Aud. Genl.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Thomas Beall 25 Coats, 25 Jackets, & 25 p<sup>rs</sup> Breeches of Cloth and 4 quins & Musket Cartridge Paper for the use of Col. Rawlings's Regiment.

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Thomas Beall scarlet Cloth suff<sup>t</sup> to make a coat & Waistcoat, with necessary Trimmings, Linen for two shirts, one p<sup>r</sup> of shoes and flannel suff<sup>t</sup> for an open coat.

The Gentlemen who has the care of the public Lead in Montgomery County is requested to deliver to Capt. Thomas Beall for the use of Col. Rawlings's Regt 100 lb Lead taking & transmitting to this Board the fact<sup>rs</sup> Rec<sup>d</sup>. that the same may be charged to the Continent.
