

Commission of a Letter of Marque and Reprisal issued to Henry Hedges
Commander of the Sloop Richmond mounting two Long guns, six Lorms
and six small arms navigated with 12 Men, to Town, Gunther Belonging
to Samuel and Robert Pinsonne & Co Baltimore

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliverto Doct: John
Johnson Cloth for a great Coat with Trimmings &c

That the said Commissary of Stores deliverto Capt: Alex^r
Turner 44 Blankets for the use of his Company

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt: Alexander
Turner one hundred and ninety eight Pounds, eight Shillings and one
penny due his Company and the further sum of twelve Pounds for the
use of Com^r Ganellon for acc'ts passed by the Princ^e & to the Agle.

(Friday) 25 September 1770

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt: Alex
Turner two hundred Pounds to be delivered over to Sam^l Hancock on Acc't

That the said Treasurer pay to Allen Quynn Thirty Pounds for
Acc't passed by the said Genl.

(Saturday) 26th September 1770

Present as on yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Michael Fay
Forty Pounds, two Shillings for acc't passed by the Princ^e & to the Agle.

(Monday) 28th September 1770

Present as on Saturday. Daniel Lanoll Esqne Attended

On the Petition of William West of Dorchester County and the
Depositions of Solomon West and Charles Carter, lodged therewith, there appearing
good ground to believe that the Inlistment of the said William West was
not voluntary but that great violence was used towards him and Measnes
highly injuriable were taken to compel him to Inlist. It is therefore
Ordered by this Board that the said Wm West be not taken or in any manner
treated as a Soldier or Deserter till the Matter be fully heard by this Board or
the further Order of this Board be obtained
