That the said Treasurer pay to Henry Schnebely Twenty five pounds ten shillings for the use of Jacob Ott for Acc't passed by the Aud. Gen.

Lieut Samuel Sadler is appointed Quarter Master to the Hospital in Baltimore formerly kept in Baltimore Town, now ordered to be kept in the Fort at Whetstone Point.

Friday 6 November 1770.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Col^r Benjamin Fitchellon Twenty pounds, fourteen shillings and six pence for the use of Zebulon Headington, one hundred and twenty nine pounds, seventeen shillings eleven pence for the use of Capt Willm Hudson & his Compy, one hundred and fifty three pounds eight shillings & one penny for the use of Capt. John Murray and his Compy, one hundred and twenty one pounds, twelve shillings for the use of Capt Birmingham Dickinson & his Compy and fifty two pounds due himself for Acc't passed by the Rwd^d S. to the Aud.
