

On 2^d Monday of November being the 9th Day of the same
Month, the General Assembly of Maryland agreeable to the Constitution and
Form of Government proceeded to the choice of a Governor whom Thomas
Johnson Esquire was chosen, His Excellency Qualified the same Day in
Presence of both Houses by taking the several Oaths required (3)

On the Day following being the 10th Day of November the
Senate and House of Delegates proceeded to the choice of the Council
to the Governor and chose Thomas Lincol, James Bruce, Daniel
Carroll, Edward Lloyd and James Hindman Esquires

Thursday 12th November 1778.

James Bruce, Daniel Carroll, Edward Lloyd and James Hindman
Esquires Attended and severally Qualified by making a Declaration
of their Belief in the Christian Religion and taking, repeating and Subscribing
the several Oaths required and Certificates filed

Thomas Johnson Jun^r was appointed Clerk to the Council
and Qualified by taking, repeating and subscribing the several Oaths
required, making a Declaration of his Belief in the Christian Religion
and also the Oath of Office and Certificate filed

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Col. William Richards
fifty Pounds, three shillings and two pence half penny for the use of Capt James
Henry, Eighty three Pounds, three shillings & six Pence for the use of Capt.
John Lynch and the further Sum of Twenty one Pounds, fourteen shillings
and two pence half penny for the use of Lieut. William Frazer as per
Accounts passed by the Aud. Genl

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Cromwell, Twelve Pounds
and also the further Sum of Twenty seven Pounds, seventeen shillings and
four pence per Accounts passed by the Jun^r G. to the Aud^r G.

That the said Treasurer pay to Adam Marchel six Pounds
ten shillings for the use of Ludwick Semmon, and the further Sum of
thirty six Pounds due himself per Accounts passed

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. John Ghislain ten Pounds and
twenty six Pounds, six shillings & six Pence due him of Ac^t passed by the Aud^r G.
