Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Elis Valtelle Eighty one Pounds, five shillings due him per Act passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup>

That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Hanson, Nineteen Pounds, thirteen shillings and four Pence and the further Sum of Twenty one Pounds sixteen shillings and ten Pence the last Sum for the use of Capt. Buck and his Compy of a Militia per Act passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup>

Tuesday 19 January 1779

Thursday 21 January 1779

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Luther & Martin Esq Two hundred and fifty Pounds per Act passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup>
