That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Jacob Hunt a q M^o Sold^r in the 7th Regt & reimbursed Fifteen Pounds, eight shillings and ten pence in Cloathing and 1 Blanket, William Fortune a q M^o Sold^r in the 7th Regiment, reimbursed, seventeen Pounds, Eighteen shillings & ten Pence in Cloathing John Canoll jun^r a q M^o Sold^r in the 1st Regiment reimbursed Thirteen Pounds, two shillings and six pence in Cloathing, James Colby a q M^o Sold^r in the 1st Regiment Discharged Twenty Pounds, six shillings and six pence in Cloathing, and Thomas Mobley a q M^o Sold^r in the 3^d Regiment Discharged, Twenty two Pounds, and three pence in Cloathing due them by an Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army
