That the said Commissary deliver to Lieut Armstrong of the 3rd Regt 2 pair Shoes to be charged to the 3rd & 1st Regt.

That the said Commissary deliver to James Dod a q^{ty} of M^{ts} in the 7th Regt. Discharged, Twenty nine Pounds, ten shillings in Cloathing due him by an Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army.
