Sold. in the 5<sup>th</sup> Regt. Dischd. Twenty seven Pounds in Clothing, Thomas Lewis a q. M. Sold. in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Regt. remitted Two Pounds Fourteen shillings & four Pence in Clothing and also to Thomas Bird a q. M. Sold. in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Regt. remitted Eleven Pounds, four shillings & ten Pence in Clothing due them by an act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army —
