Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Frederick Green One thousand eight hundred and Eighty two Pounds, two Shillings & six Pence due him of Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud. G<sup>l</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Keith Treasurer Pounds eleven Shillings and eight Pence due him as a Stopper to the Governor Council to the 23<sup>rd</sup> Inst.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bruce Esquire Two hundred and fourteen Pounds ten Shillings for Carriage from & to the Landing, Quinting and Bolting 1470 Bushels Wheat a 7<sup>th</sup> of Bushel for the use of the State Troops per Agreement with the Governor Council.

That the said Treasurer Exchange for Capt Thomas Beall, of one of the Rifle Companies four hundred Dollars the present by the General Assembly agreeable to a Resolve of the same Commission issued to Edward Bruce appointed Lieut of Frederick County.

Sunday 26 April 1779

Ordered that the Company of Men deliver to Lieut Isaac Rawlings of the North Company in Army Linen for 2 Shirts & Cloth for a p<sup>r</sup> Brewer & Sackett

That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay to John Thompson Purchaser of Queen Anns County One thousand Pounds to be expended in the purchase of Wheat, Flour & Bread

Commission issued to Joseph & Merckm appointed Coron<sup>r</sup> in Anne Arundel County

Tuesday 27 April 1779

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Adam & Hartley Thirty six Pounds due him as Adjutant to Col<sup>l</sup> Wells Batt Fred. County Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph White seven Pounds, twelve Shillings and six Pence due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel & Muns Six Pounds the Allowance for assisting Charles Rawlings Adjutant in the 1<sup>st</sup> Regt. Reg<sup>t</sup> of Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Wood just One hundred and ninety nine Pounds & seven Pence for the use of John Ballist, Five Pounds, ten Shillings for the use of John Shockey, Three Pounds, fifteen Shillings for the use of William Meyer and also three Pounds ten Shillings for the use of a Capt<sup>r</sup> Hartcock of Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Depy Aud.

Permission given to William Smith Esq<sup>r</sup> Agent for the Honble Congress to Ship on Board into the Schooner Hazard Capt Perkins her full Load of Flour for Portsmouth in the State of New Hampshire the same being in consequence of Orders of the Navy Board the said Vessel Clearing out with the Naval Officer at Baltimore

We request that you will deliver into the Hands of Mr Thomas Hanwood Treasurer of the western shore all the Continental Bills of Credit of the Emissions of the 20<sup>th</sup> May 1777 and the 11<sup>th</sup> of April 1778 in your Hands as Treasurer of the Eastern shore taking his Receipt therefor on the Aud. of the Quota of this State & lodging the Receipt with the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup> who is to give you a Receipt for that which you deliver to him
