Eleven Pounds, ten shillings due him in lieu of Rations of acct. passed by the Deputy Aud.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut. John Crapper of the Baltimore
Galley 92 Rations in the following Species of acct. lodged with & passed by the Deputy Aud.
57 1/2 lb Bread, 57 1/2 lb Flour, 57 1/2 lb Beef & 46 lb Pork

Leave is hereby given if his Excellency General Washington shall approve the same and accordingly
grant Permission and not otherwise, to a Mrs. Aetjah Chamier Widow of Daniel Chamier Esquire
Deceased to Ship in New York onboard an Unarmed Vessel and thence to Transport to Hampton
Road in Virginia her Household Furniture and Wearing Apparel where the same may be received
onboard Bay Craft and carried to Baltimore, Mrs. Chamier sending with the Goods a particular
Invoice, of the Household Furniture and of the Marks and Numbers of the Packages of her
Wearing Apparel, and making an Affidavit endorsed on the Invoice that the Goods therein
mentioned are her own Property and for her own use
