Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to Capt Nathan Williams of the 6<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>, Three thousand Dollars to be expended in the recruiting Service, he being appointed by Gen<sup>l</sup> Smallwood & having his Instructions of the 9<sup>th</sup> April for that purpose

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty Four Pounds, ten shillings for the use of Am<sup>l</sup> Mary Miller, Ten Pounds, ten shillings & five pence for the use of Abraham H. J. Twenty three Pounds, fifteen shillings for the use of Daniel Linds and also the further Sum of Eighty nine Pounds, sixteen shillings for the use of Capt Richard Haff & his Comp<sup>y</sup> per Act<sup>s</sup> passed by the Depy & Aud<sup>s</sup>

That the said Treasurer pay to William Jones, fourteen Pounds, ten shillings for the use of John Deaver who was a 9<sup>th</sup> M<sup>l</sup> Sold<sup>r</sup> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>.
