

Thursday 13rd May 1779

Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered that the western shire Treasurer pay to Capt Nathan Williams of the 6th Regt. Three Thousand Dollars to be expended in the recruiting service, he being appointed by Genl Smallwood & having his Instructions of the 9th April for that purpose.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty Four Pounds, ten shillings for the use of Ann a Mary Miller, One Pound, ten shillings & five pence for the use of Abraham H. Jr. Twenty three Pounds, fifteen shillings for the use of Daniel Daniels and also the further sum of Eighty nine Pounds, nineteen shillings for the use of Capt Richard Haff & his Compy per Act passed by the Depy. Comd^d.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Jones, Thirteen Pounds, ten shillings for the use of John Deaver who was a M^t Soldier in the 3^d Maryland Regt. Discharged bala due him in lieu of Clothing allowed by the Genl Assembly in the Act to procure Troops for the American Army and also the further sum of twelve Pounds due himself for enlisting 2 Recruits per Certificate allowed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Clement Deall, two Pounds for the use of Jacob Sprout & Thirty seven Pounds ten shillings for the use of William Davis per Account paid by the said Genl.

That the Company of Store deliver to Boston Farmer a Q^t M^t Soldier in the 7th Regt. the sum of Twenty nine Pounds, ten shillings in Clothing due him by an Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army.
