have good grounds to believe that the going at Large of the said Robert Miles may be  
dangerous to this State, the State of Virginia being actually invaded by the Enemy. Wherefore the  
said Robert Miles is hereby committed to the Public Goal in the City of Annapolis to be  
there kept in the Custody of the Sheriff of Ann Arundel County there to remain until he shall  
be discharged therefrom according to Law.

one Blanket due him by an act of assembly to procure Troops for the American Army

& Smallwoods Instructions of the 9<sup>th</sup> April for that purpose.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut John Hardman twenty two Pounds for  
the use of William Veazy 3<sup>d</sup> due him per acct. pass'd by the Depty Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson just out of the Money sent  
in Congress for the Purchase of Wheat & flour, Forty thousand Pounds to be sent and  
charged to Samuel Gelpin of Cecil County & to be accounted for
