The Militia of Col. Weems and Col. Robinsons Battalions ordered to Annapolis having as represented to this Board by their Officers, shewed such a strong Desire to be discharged that there is too much Reason to believe that many of them will go to their Homes without if they do not obtain permission some of them having already gone without leave This Board think it more advisable to discharge them for the present especially as they have no late Intelligence from whence it may be collected that the Enemy design up the Bay immediately if at all.
