Mr John Lynn of a Montgomery County was recommended to the Board of War for an appointment as Ensign in the 6th Maryland Regiment.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Lynn Two thousand Pounds out of the Money sent by Congress to be by him delivered over to Richard Brooke to be expended in the Purchase of Wheat & Flour and accounted for

This Board on Enquiry into the Circumstances of Samuel Carter's Enlistment into the a Kings Service of this State are Unanimously of opinion that the said Enlistment is good and valid and ought to be binding on the said Samuel Carter agreeable to the Resolve of the Convention for raising a Regiment for the Service of this State

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western shore deposit in the Hands of the Commissioners of the Continental Loan Office in this State, all the Continental Bills of Credit of the Emigrations of a May 1777 and April 1778 which are in his Hands as Treasurer, belonging to this State and that he take three Certificates of nearly equal Sums making up in the whole the amount of those Bills of Credit to exchange the same for this State according to the Resolutions of Congress

That the said Treasurer pay to Benjamin Waiter Eight thousand Pounds to be delivered over to William McBride and to be expended in the Purchase of Wheat & Flour & accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Dallam forty thousand Pounds to be by him delivered over to Richard Dallam to be expended in the Purchase of Wheat and Flour & accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to Benjamin Waiter Two hundred and eleven Pounds, ten shillings for the use of Jos. Darhull of a^u papered by the Depty Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beard two Pounds, five shillings
