Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt James Fernandez four thousand Dollars, two thousand to be delivered over to Lieut William Bruce of the 1st Regiment, and two thousand to be delivered over to Lieut Samuel W. Johnson of the same Regiment, to be expended in the recruiting Service

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt James Fernandez Two hundred and fifty Pounds to be delivered over to John Beale Sumner to be expended in the Purchase of Provisions for the Recruits in Charles County & to be accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to Joshua Smith Sixty Pounds paid by D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Deborah Maybony Twenty six Pounds eight Shillings and three pence paid by the Depy. Aud. and also the further Sum of One hundred Pounds on Account.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt James Fernandez 10 Coats 10 pair Socks & 10 pair Shoes to be charged to the 1 Regt. 2 pair Shoes for himself and 2 pair Shoes for Lieut William Bruce and Groves suff. for 2 Bagg. to be returned

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Thomas M'Kew a q M^o Soldier in the 3^d Regiment, Discharged the amount of Eighteen Pounds, Fifteen Shillings & three Pence in Cloathing due him by an Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army
