Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to William Coombe a q^{rs} Soldier in the 1st Regiment Discharged the amount of Twenty three Pounds, three shillings and six pence in Clothing Bal^d due him per Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army.

Saturday 12th June 1779

Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Major Nathaniel Smith two hundred and fifty Pounds to be delivered over to Lieut Sam^l Sadler, of the Baltimore & Catholics on account, and also the further Sum of Eighteen thousand Pounds to be delivered over to Robert Buchanan Esq. to be expended in the purchase of Wheat, Flour &c for the use of the Continental Army. — to be accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Keith nine Pounds due him per account passed by the Depy. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. George Keports one thousand Pounds on account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt James Fernandes, sixteen Pounds twelve shillings and six pence of account passed by the Depy. Aud.

That George Keports collect and receive into his charge all the arms & accoutrements in Baltimore County belonging to this State that they may be ready for Service occasionally and that the Officers of the Militia assist him in the said Collection

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Major Nathaniel Smith 30 Shirts 50 pair Shoes, 70 pair Overalls & 4 Blankets for the Baltimore Catholics

Capt. George Keports is appointed armourer at Baltimore, where the principal Part of the Arms now are on the pay of 200 Dollars of Calendar Month to commence from the 20th of last Month
