

Commissions of Letters of Marque & Reprisal issued to James Buchanan Commander of the Schooner Revenge, 120 Tons burthen, mounting 12 Carriage Guns, 4 Howitz & 20 small arms belonging to Charles Wallace & others of the State of Maryland and also to Benjamin Coley Commander of the Ship Charming 20 Tons burthen mounting 12 Carriage Guns 7 Howitz & 20 small arms belonging to Samuel & Robert Curwin & others of Baltimore.

Ordered that Capt Campbell deliver to Capt James Buchanan of the Brig? Revenge 1 Barrel Cannon Powder & 30 lb of 4th shot, (30 ball was delivered of 2nd) and also to Capt John Cook of the Schooner Baltimore here 200 lb Cannon Powder, 50 lb Muskets Do. 6 lb Match rope and 200 lb of 2nd shot, the shot to be ret. in kind (100. 3rd shot delivered)

Tuesday 15th June 1779

Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Coyt William Smart of the 1st Reg^t two thousand five hundred Dollars to be delivered over to Lieut Samuel & Wetheron of the 1st Reg^t and also two thousand five hundred Dollars to be delivered over to Lieut William Bruce of the 1st Reg^t to be expended in the recruiting service.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Coley Twenty Pounds five shillings & six pence in lieu of Clothing due him as a private Soldier for Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army.

That the said Treasurer pay to William & How sixteen Pounds for the use of Elizabeth & How due her for account passed by the Depty Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut William Judah one thousand Two hundred & ten Pounds thirteen shillings & six pence on account.

That the commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut William Judah 23 pair of Shoes 1 Blanket 2 Hats & 15 pair Overalls for the use of the Baltimore & Katoxos in the Galley Conqueror.

Ordered that the commissary of Stores deliver to Sergeant Penelt of Capt Davidson's Compy of the 2nd Maryland Reg^t 1 Shirt, 2 Coats, 1st Overalls 2 Hats & 1 pair Shoes for a recruit of that Compy 2nd Overalls a pair of Shoes & a shirt for himself.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Joseph & Middleton two hundred and two Pounds ten shillings due him for Act passed by the Depty Aud^r.

That the Board have agreed to sell to Samuel Chase Esq 200 lb Cannon Powder at 40¢ per lb and an Order drawn to Capt Keppel for the delivery thereof.
