Tuesday 6th July 1779

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores at Baltimore deliver to Major Smith and Lieut Sadler Cloth sufficient to make them each a suit of Cloaths

Wednesday 7th July 1779

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to William Hopkins a 9 M^o Soldier in the 7 Reg^t Discharged Twenty nine Pounds, ten shillings in Cloathing and also to William Blades a 9 M^o Soldier in the 7 Reg^t Discharged Twenty nine Pounds, ten shillings in Cloathing due them by an Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Sergeant Penick of the 2^d Regiment

3 Blankets and 2 pair Shoes for said Regiment.

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Sergeant Halkerton of the 3^d Reg^t 13 Shirts, 13 Coats, 13 pair Smalls, 13 pair Shoes, 13 Blankets & 13 Knapsacks for so many Recruits belonging to the 1st Regiment and to be charged to the same.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Jonathan Rawlings Twenty one Pounds five shillings due him for account passed by the said Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Wallace Esq. Paymaster one thousand Pounds on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to John & Muir three thousand nine hundred and fifty nine Pounds, five shillings & three pence for the use of William & Muir for accounts passed by the said Gen^l.
