That the Commissary of Stores deliver to S^{er} & Neary of the 1 Reg^t 1 p^r Shoes, & 1 p^r Stockings (p^o Col^l Stones order)

That the said Commissary deliver to S^{er} Joshua Lamb of the 1 Reg^t 3 Coats, 3 Hats, 2 p^{rs} Shoes & 1 p^r Bonnets to be charged to the same Regiment

It appearing to this Board by Sundry Letters now produced from Owen Biddle Assistant Commissary General of Forage and amongst them those of the 14th July & the 17th of August last Directed to Henry Hollingworth of Cecil County that he the said Henry Hollingworth is appointed a Deputy Assistant Commissary General in this State The Commissary General of Forage being a Branch of the Quarter & Master General Department Licence is hereby granted to the said Henry Hollingworth according to the act of Assembly in such Case lately made and provided to act and transact in this State as Deputy Assistant Commissary General of Forage aforesaid

The Commission of Henry Wright S^{er} Assistant Deputy Forage & Master General from Henry Hollingworth of the 10th Day of this Instant Sept^r being produced to this Board Licence is hereby given to him the said Henry Wright jun^r to act as an Assistant Deputy Forage & Master Gen^l in all the Counties of the Eastern shore of this State except Cecil by Virtue and according to the act of Assembly in such Case made and Provided

The Commission of John Green to be Assistant Deputy Quarter & Master Gen^l of the Army of the United States in the Lower part of Frederick and the Upper Part of Baltimore Counties & the Com^o of Henry Struock to be ^{Asst} Deputy Quarter & Master General of the Army of the United States in Washington County dated 2nd June 1778. The Com^o of David Poo Asst^{nt} Deputy Quarter & Master Gen^l of the Army of the United States in Baltimore County dated the 11th of April 1778 and the Com^o of Thomas Richardson Assistant Deputy Q^uarter Master Gen^l of the Army of the United States in Montgomery County dated 1 July 1778 from James Calhoun Esq^r Deputy Quarter & Master Gen^l being produced to this Board Licence is hereby given to them to act in the Counties aforesaid according to the act of Assembly in such Case lately made and Provided
