Ordered That the western show Treasurer pay to Thomas Lewis four pounds thirteen and nine pence of the new Emission value of one hundred and eighty four pounds, ten shillings and six pence per account papered by the Deputy and

That the said Treasurer pay to William I. Smith Esq. Surgeon of the 6<sup>th</sup> Regiment four pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence of the same Emission value of one hundred and ninety six pounds due him per ac<sup>t</sup> papered by the Deputy and

That the Eastern show Treasurer pay to John Page fifty eight pounds and ten shillings of the same Emission value of two thousand three hundred and fifty eight pounds, shilling and three pence due him per ac<sup>t</sup> papered by the said Gen<sup>l</sup>

That the Commissary deliver to William I. Smith Surgeon Major of the 6<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> thirteen and an half gallon of Rum and twenty two and an half pounds of Coffee deficiency of Stores to the 31<sup>st</sup> Oct. inclusive.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to the said William I. Smith, Cloth and Trimmings sufficient for a suit of Coats and Linen for two Shirts on account.

Friday 24<sup>th</sup> November 1780.

Ordered That the western show Treasurer pay to John Brewer four pounds of the new Emission value of one hundred and fifty pounds due him per ac<sup>t</sup> papered by the said

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. James Murray eighty pounds of the same Emission on account.

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> November 1780.

Commission issued to David Harris appointed Capt in the room of Thomas Yates in the Baltimore Town Batt. of Militia in Baltimore County.

Ordered That the Armourer deliver to Capt Gilbert Middleton four hundred pounds of Lead to be delivered over to Col. George Darwell Lieut of Somerset County.

That the western show Treasurer pay to Lieut Thomas Luckett of the late Col. Rawlings's Regiment, who has lately returned from captivity, three pounds and fifteen shillings of the new Emission value of one hundred and fifty pounds the Gratuity allowed by a Resolution of the General Assembly of the 10<sup>th</sup> December 1778 and also the further Sum of Fifty Dollars of the same Emission value of two thousand Dollars, value of the articles for the year 1779 according to the "Act relating to the Officers and Soldiers of this State in the American Army and other purposes therein mentioned"

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to the said Lieut Thomas Luckett Cloth and Trimmings for a suit of Coats and Linen for four Shirts due him for the year according to the Act of Assembly.

Commissions issued according to the Recommendation of the House of Delegates to John Morris appointed Register of Wills for Worcester County in the room of William [resigned] and also to Thomas Belt appointed Register of Wills for Washington County in the room of Thomas Sprigg resigned.

The Justices of the peace and Orphans Court for St. Marys Kent, Caroline, Charles, Calvert, Montgomery, Talbot, Talbot, Dorchester & the Counties, and also the Judges of the Orphans Court for Baltimore, Frederick Counties are re-appointed and continued under their former Commissions.
