Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Wilmer Esquire
One hundred and Twenty eight Pounds Eight Shillings and two pence of the new
Division instead of Seven thousand, one hundred and thirty five Pounds, six shillings &
ten pence half penny to be deliv^r over to John Rawlings & deliv^red by the Judge.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullock Esq^r one thousand, two
hundred and thirty seven Pounds on account.

Samuel T. Wright Esq^r elected a Member of the Council to the Governor app-
ointed after his application & took his seat accordingly. —
