That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay over to the western shore Treasurer thirty thousand one hundred and forty two pounds, one shilling and three pence Continental Currency, six hundred and forty seven pounds, one shilling and three pence of the new Emission of this State and one hundred and eighty five thousand three hundred and twenty Pounds of Tobacco. —
