Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December 1780.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Col<sup>o</sup> James Kinman Seventeen Pounds ten Shillings of the new Emission on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to James Brue Esquire Fifty three Pounds of the same Emission on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Lloyd Beall of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment one Pound thirteen Shillings of the same Emission in lieu of sixty six Pounds due him per Account passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt David Lynn of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment Three pounds nine Shillings of the same Emission in lieu of one hundred and thirty eight Pounds due him per Account passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Jesse Hollingsworth Ten hhd<sup>s</sup> of Tobacco weighing nine thousand eight hundred and eighty nine pounds for which he is to pay Fifty pounds per hundred and four p<sup>er</sup> cent for the hark. —

That Christopher Edelm Collector of the Tax for Frederick County pay to George Hurdock appointed purchasing Commissary to the Convention Troops and their Guard one thousand five hundred Pounds Continental Money and thirty thousand Pounds of Tobacco to be by him accounted for. —

That the Young Commissary deliver to Captain Lloyd Beall four Gallons of Rum fifteen pounds of Sugar, and nine pounds of Coffee and also to Captain David Lynn eighteen Gallons of Rum, sixty eight pounds of Sugar and thirty seven and a half pounds of Coffee the deficiency of Stores to the 30<sup>th</sup> Nov. inclusive

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Captain Lloyd Beall for the use of Francis Rogers a Substitute from Montgomery County for the Maryland Line a Suit of Cloaths the Com<sup>ty</sup> allowed him by the Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly. —

William Sleath appointed Inspector for Princess Ann Town in Somerset County in the room of John Saw who resigned. —

Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> December 1780.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Col<sup>o</sup> Joseph Dashiell two thousand eight hundred and fifty Pounds on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to John H. Stone Esq<sup>r</sup> Two thousand Pounds in part of his Salary on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Minner Twenty thousand Pounds to be delivered over to Captain Richard Conway of Alexandria on Account for Goods purchased of him by this Board. —

That the said Treasurer pay to George Poe eight hhd<sup>s</sup> of Tobacco weighing eight thousand and eighty one pounds net to be accounted for at sixty pounds p<sup>er</sup> cent and four p<sup>er</sup> cent —
