one and a half pounds of Coffee and also to Ensign Gabriel Jacob of the same Company  
Eight gallons of Rum thirty two pounds of Sugar and eighteen pounds of Coffee due them  
to the 22<sup>d</sup> of November last.

That the Armourer deliver to Major John Steward one pound of glazed powder.

four pounds, sixteen shillings and six pence due him per acct. paper by the Depty Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Oliver Walkers seventy five pounds  
due her per account paper by the Aud. Gen. —

That the Armourer deliver to Col. John Dorcey ten Muskets to be  
returned, or paid for in kind if injured or lost, five pound powder and five pound Cannon &  
and also to Captain William Campbell one hundred Gun Barrels to be by him stocked  
agreeable to Contract.

That John Dorcey and Comp<sup>y</sup> pay to Richard Dallam Esq. Eight  
thousand pounds Currency to be charged to account of Tobacco purchased of this Board. —

Horses seventy three pounds, three shillings of the new Emission value of Two thousand  
nine hundred and twenty five pounds, nineteen shillings and six pence on account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jesse Hollingsworth twelve hhd<sup>s</sup> of  
Tobacco, eleven thousand seven hundred and fourteen pounds net to be accounted for at  
sixty pounds per hundred and four p cent —

Ordered that the western show Treasurer pay to Charles Sanddale  
three pounds, fifteen shillings of the new Emission value of one hundred and fifty  
pounds to be delivered over to John Frazer and him per account paper by the  
Aud. General. —
