That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Robert Reith five yards of Linnen to line a pair of breeches and waistcoat —

That Mr. Thomas Donnellan deliver to James Galthorn Esquire, what public Salt he may want taking his Receipt therefor. —

Permission is hereby given to Captain William Lockran a British Prisoner taken by Capt James Buchanan of the Brig Schoer, to go into the City of New York or Charles Town to solicit his Exchange for Aquila Adams late Commander of the Butcher Merchantman now a prisoner of War on parole to Commodore Gayton, in case the Exchange should not be effected, the said Lockran to return when required. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Longden, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen pounds to be delivered over to Robert T. Hood of Alexandria evacuated by him to Exchequer under a Resolution of Congress per Account passed by the Depy Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Senifer Surgeon in the Hospital Department nine pounds eighteen shillings of the new Emission for himself & nine pounds eighteen shillings of the same Emission to be delivered over to James Craik chief Physician in the Hospital Department due them per Aud^o passed by the Aud^o —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Daniel Senifer, Cloth and Trimmings sufficient for a suit of Cloath and Linnen for four Shirts the Articles allowed by the general Assembly for the present year —

That the Shipping Commissary deliver to the said Daniel Senifer and James Craik each ninety five pounds brown Sugar, twenty gallons of Rum and fifty four pounds of Coffee for the present year inclusive. —

Tuesday 19th December 1780.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Col^o Henry Hollingsworth six thousand nine hundred and two pounds fifteen shillings on Account — and also the further sum of one thousand pounds of the new Emission on Account —

That Captain George Keports deliver to Stephen Steward what Military Stores he may think necessary for the Sloop Porpoise for the purpose of her present Destination. —
