

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut John Green two pounds, twelve shillings and seven pence half penny of the new Emission in lieu of one hundred and fifteen pounds due him per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by the A<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>.  
That the said Treasurer pay to Gabriel Patterson Vanhorne Eighty eight Pounds, four shillings and ten pence of the same Emission in lieu of three thousand five hundred and twenty five pounds, thirteen shillings and nine pence due him per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by the A<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> —

That the Stopping Commissary deliver to Capt William Middleton of the Dolphin, two gallons of Rum for himself per Month, two rations per Day eight pounds of sugar and four and a half pounds of coffee per Month and one and a half gallons of Rum for each Squad per Month and one ration per Day from the fifteenth of the present Month. —

Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> December 1780.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Carroll Esquire Fifty pounds of the new Emission on Ac<sup>t</sup> —

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker five pounds, three shillings of the same Emission in lieu of two hundred and fifty pounds due him per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by the A<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> —

Thursday 28 December 1780.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Martin Morris six pounds, two shillings of the new Emission in lieu of two hundred and forty four pounds due him per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by the A<sup>d</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> —

That the said Treasurer pay to Col<sup>l</sup> Matthew Driver fourteen shillings and four pence of the same Emission in lieu of twenty nine pounds, sixteen shillings and three pence for the use of Vincent Price due him per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by D. A<sup>d</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to His Excellency Thomas Sim Lee Esquire forty five pounds, fifteen shillings and six pence of the same Emission on Ac<sup>t</sup> —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Wilmoth sixteen shillings and ten pence half penny in lieu of thirty three pounds, fifteen shillings per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by the A<sup>d</sup> General. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Key seven hundred and fifty Pounds of the same Emission to be delivered over to George Muddock on Ac<sup>t</sup> —

That the Armourer deliver to Thomas Norton one thousand five hundred pieces with eight Ammunition, fifteen Muskets & Carbines, twenty round shot to each Muskets to be delivered over to Col<sup>l</sup> John Weeks for the use of the Militia of Ann Arundel County. —

Friday 29<sup>th</sup> December 1780.

Ordered That Mr John Shaw immediately repair the damages belonging to the Small Cannon or Six pieces at this place, and where they cannot be repaired to be serviceable, that new ones be made. —

It appears to this Board from Information given that Andrew McCarty of 4<sup>th</sup> Kings County and Clark Pilot and resident of said County and David Hunter Pilot and resident of Calvert County have been seen with the Enemy, and this and the neighbouring State being at this time invaded by privateers and forces of the Enemy — We deem the going at Large of the said Andrew McCarty Clark
