

Ordered That the Commissary Deliver to Captains Robert Chesely, John Sprigg Belt, and James Lingan, each, twenty four Gallons of Rum and ninety six pounds of sugar due them for the Year 1780 inclusive -

Ordered That the Western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt Henry Lyles of the 3rd Regim^t Capt Robert Chesely of the 2nd Regim^t Capt. John S. Belt of the 4th Regim^t and Capt James Lingan of the late Rawlings's Regiment each, nineteen pounds, four shillings and nine pence of the new Emission in lieu of seven hundred and fifty pounds ten shillings due them per Account passed by the Aud^g General. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Snowden Taylor, one pound nineteen shillings and two pence of the same Emission in lieu of seventy eight pounds, five shillings and eight pence due him per Account passed by the Aud^g Gen^l. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bryer Esquire one hundred Dollars of the same Emission on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to George Leigh two hundred and fifty pounds of the same Emission to be delivered over to Capt Joseph Ford on Account.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Henry Gaither of the 1st Regt Cloth and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths and Linnen for two Suits and him in full for the present year - and also to Thomas Hunter and John Cheney late Soldiers of the 1st Regim^t each, one Coat on Account -

That the Western Shore Treasurer pay to the said Lieut Clement Skerret thirty pounds of the new Emission agreeable to a Resolution of the General Assembly passed 30th December last on Account -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Thomas Celand eleven pounds five shillings of the same Emission in lieu of four hundred and fifty pounds due himself, Three pounds, two shillings and six pence of the same Emission in lieu of one hundred and twenty five pounds for the use of Gideon Ireland and also Three pounds, two shillings and six pence of the same Emission in lieu of one hundred and twenty five pounds for the use of Druew Greaves and them per Accounts passed by the Aud^g Gen^l. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Col. James Kent fifty nine pounds fourteen shillings and seven pence half penny of the same Emission in lieu of two thousand seven hundred and eighty nine pounds five shillings to be delivered over to Col. Philip Piddeman per Act passed by the Aud^g Gen^l. -
