for the use of the wounded men in the Hospital. —

That the Ordnance deliver to Lieut Skinner one pair Bullet  
clounds and two quins smallet Cartridge paper to be delivered over to Joseph  
Wilkinson Esquire Lieutenant of Calvert County for the use of the Militia of said County

That the Standing Commissary deliver to Daniel Eakin a Deputy  
from the British sixt Five Days provisions to enable him to proceed on his  
way to Philadelphia —

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Jeremiah Townly  
Chafe Esquire one hundred and fifty pounds of the new Emission on Account of  
his Salary for the year 1780. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt John Gale fifty nine  
pounds, seventeen shillings and nine pence three farthings of the same Emission

nine pence of the same Emission in lieu of seven hundred and sixty nine pounds, ten  
shillings and three pence per acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the said Genl. and also the further Sum of  
fifty pounds, each, of the same Emission on account according to a Resolution of  
the General Assembly. —
