Wednesday 24. January 1781.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Joseph Cowman One thousand pounds to be delivered over to Hopkins Wilson and Moses Batson due them on account of Tobacco purchased of this State.

That the said Treasurer pay to William McKey Seven hundred and nine pounds, fourteen shillings and nine pence of the new Emision value of twenty eight thousand three hundred and eighty nine pounds ten shillings due him per Account paid by the Aud<sup>r</sup> General. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Giles eleven hundred and fifty pounds, fourteen shillings and nine pence of the same Emision value of forty six thousand and thirty seven pounds ten shillings to be delivered over to Samuel Gilpin due him per Account paid by the Aud<sup>r</sup> General. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Col<sup>r</sup> Uxbridge Forest Cloth and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths for the year 1780 and Cloth for a Coat and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two Shirts in part of the Articles for the year 1780.

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> January 1781. —

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut Philip Hill of the 2<sup>d</sup> Regiment nineteen pounds four shillings and nine pence of the new Emision value of seven hundred and fifty nine pounds, ten shillings due him for Stores per Account paid by the Depy Aud<sup>r</sup> and also the further sum of fifty pounds of the same Emision agreeable to a Resolution of the Gen<sup>r</sup> Assembly of the pres<sup>t</sup> Session on Acc<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut James Maubbin Ensign of the late Rawlings<sup>r</sup> Regt. Twenty pounds of the same Emision Balance due him of the Fifty pounds agreeable to a Resolution of the present Session of Assembly.

That the said Treasurer pay to Luther Martin Esquire two thousand nine hundred and seventy seven pounds, ten shillings due him for the like sum borrowed of him by the State in May 1780. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Moore twenty eight pounds eighteen shillings and eight pence of the new Emision value of eleven hundred and fifty seven pounds, eight shillings and three pence due him per Acc<sup>r</sup> paid by the D<sup>r</sup> Aud<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Smith Forty pounds eight shillings and one penny of the same Emision value of one thousand six hundred and fifteen pounds, five shillings and sum per Account paid by the D<sup>r</sup> Aud<sup>r</sup>. —

That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay to Dr<sup>r</sup> Sullivan, Six hundred and fifty five pounds, twelve shillings and nine pence of the same Emision value of twenty six thousand two hundred and forty five pounds, eleven shillings and three pence for the use of Lewis Kirkman and also eleven pounds, thirteen shillings and nine pence for the use of Nathan Bradley due them per Accounts paid by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>r</sup> —

That the western shore Treasurer pay to David Poe Continental Quarter master for the District of Baltimore Town forty shds of Tobacco amounting to Seven thousand one hundred and three pounds for the use of that Department on Account and to be charged to the United States. —

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Lieut Philip Hill twenty gallons of Rum & ninety six pounds of sugar due him for 1780. —
