Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> January 1781.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Joseph Cowman and three thousand pounds to be delivered over to Hopkins Wilson and Moore Watson and them on account of Tobacco purchased of this State.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Wiley seven hundred and nine pounds, fourteen shillings and nine pence of the new Emission in lieu of twenty eight thousand, three hundred and eighty nine pounds ten shillings due him per Account passed by the Aud<sup>r</sup> General. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Giles eleven hundred and fifty pounds, fourteen shillings and nine pence of the same Emission in lieu of forty six thousand and thirty seven pounds ten shillings to be delivered over to Samuel Gilpin due him per Account passed by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Col<sup>o</sup> Urial Forest Cloth and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths for the year 1780 and Cloth for a Coat and Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths and Linn for two Shirts in part of the Articles for the year 1780.

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> January 1781. —

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut Philip Hill of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Regiment nineteen pounds, four shillings and nine pence of the new Emission in lieu of seven hundred and sixty nine pounds, ten shillings due him for Store per Account passed by the Depty Aud<sup>r</sup> and also the further Sum of fifty pounds of the same Emission agreeable to a Resolution of the Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the pres<sup>t</sup> Session on Act.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut James Maubottom Lingard of the late Rawlins's Regim<sup>t</sup>. Twenty pounds of the same Emission Balance due him of the Fifty pounds agreeable to a Resolution of the present Session of Assembly.

That the said Treasurer pay to Luther Martin Esquire two thousand nine hundred and seventy seven pounds, ten shillings due him for the sum borrowed of him by the State in May 1780. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Moor twenty eight pounds, eighteen shillings and eight pence of the new Emission in lieu of eleven hundred and fifty seven pounds, eight shillings and three pence due him per Act. passed by the D. Aud<sup>r</sup>.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Smith forty pounds eight shillings and one penny of the same Emission in lieu of one thousand five hundred and fifteen pounds, five shillings due him per Account passed by the D. Aud<sup>r</sup>. —

That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay to Doct. Sullivan, five hundred and fifty five pounds, twelve shillings and nine pence of the same Emission in lieu of twenty six thousand two hundred and twenty five pounds, eleven shillings and three pence for the use of Levin Kirkman and also eleven pounds, thirteen shillings and nine pence for the use of Nathaniel Bradley due them per Accounts passed by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the western shore Treasurer pay to David Poe Continental Quarter master for the District of Baltimore Town forty Loads of Tobacco amounting to seven thousand one hundred and three pounds for the use of that Department on Account and to be charged to the United States. —

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Lieut Philip Hill twenty gallons of Rum & ninety six pounds of sugar due him for 1780. —
