 each, four shirts for the year 1700. and also to James Fraik Physician Genl
 in the Hospital Department a suit of Cloaths and Linnen for four shirts for the year 1700

agreeable to the Constitution and Form of Government, the Council
 proceeded to the choice of a Comptroller in the room of Daniel Carroll Esquire, who resigned
 his Seat by Letter on the 17th Instant, when Stephen West, Samuel Hanson, Edward
 Coursey, James McHenry and John Brue were put in nomination, and the
 Brue had an equal number, The Council then proceeded to Ballot a second
 time confirming their Ballots to the said four Gentlemen having an equal
 number of votes and the Ballots being again equal for the said four Gentlemen
 the Council proceeded to determine the Election by Lot, which fell upon Stephen
 West Esquire who is declared duly elected. —

 thousand three hundred and fifty pounds due him per Ac^t passed by the Aud^r of G^l

That the said Treasurer pay to Abis Redman, one pound seven
 -teen shillings and six pence of the same Emission value of seventy six pounds
 due her per Account passed by the Depy Aud^r. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Stephen Steward and Jon
 Stephen three hundred pounds of the same Emission on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Mumo twelve
 pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission on Account.

That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay to James Hindman
 fifty seven pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission value of two thousand
 three hundred pounds for a Horse purchased of Alexander Anderson for the use
 of the State on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Milburn four
 thousand pounds to be delivered over to Col^l Samuel Smith on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Gilbert Middleton, one
 thousand pounds to be expended in the purchase of Sundry Articles for the
 Dolphin and plate to be accounted for. —
