Sunday 28th January 1781.

Ordered that the western show Treasurer pay to Major John Stump
four thousand and fifty six and two thirds of a Dollar to be delivered over to Hugh
Steward junr. on account of the late Expedition of the Porpoise Sloop and to be
by him accounted for. —

This Board having fully examined John Stump Ind. or Jon of John
and his Books and papers seized by the Lieutenant of Harford County pursuant
to their warrant, and considered the same, are of Opinion that the said John
Stump's going at large is dangerous to the State and do therefore order that
the said John Stump be confined to Harford County and do not depart there-
from without the license of the Governor and Council for the time being first
obtained and that the said John Stump give Bond to the State with one
good and sufficient Security in the penalty of two thousand pounds current
Money not to depart the said County without Leave as aforesaid and in
the mean time to be of good Behaviour towards the State. —

Monday 29th January 1781.

Ordered that Capt Philomen Warfets deliver to Johnson Smith five barrels
of Cannon powder to be delivered to Robert T. Hoag Esquire to be by him returned. —

That the Armourer deliver to the said Johnson Smith two musket powder
and four quires Cannon Cartridge paper, to be delivered to Robt. T. Hoag & returned
and also to Capt Robert Berry one 6th Cannon, fifty muskets, one hundred
Cannon Cartridges, one hundred five pound short thirty pound Musket powder to be
delivered over to Col. Barnes Lieut of St. Marys County for the use of the
Militia of said County and fifty Musket Cartridges for the present Cruise as a
look out Boat to be returned if not used. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt John Lewis Jones
of the 7th Regiment Lieut William T. Hadcock of the 5th and General Smallwood
each, a Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts for the year 1781. — and
also to Major John Steward a Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts
for the year 1781. — and Aquila Deau, Jesse Gray, Paul Richards and
Thomas Bailey of the 3rd Lawrence Hurdles, William Lynch of the 7th and
William Roberts, Benjamin Gray and John Mitchell of the 1st Regiment, each,
a Suit of Cloaths, one hat and one Blanket.

The western show Treasurer pay to John King thirty five pounds, twelve
shillings and five pence of the new Emission in lieu of one thousand four hundred and fifty
five pounds and four pence paid by the Dept and —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullen three hundred and ninety
pounds of the same Emission on acct. —

That the Young Commissary deliver to Capt Robt. Berry five
Days provisions for five men to act as look out —
