

Tuesday 30th January 1701.

Commission issued to John Hull, Joseph Sprigg, Henry Schnebely, Joseph Chapline, John Barnes, Richard Davis, Andrew Drew, Andrew Rench, William Yeates, Lemuel Banet, Christopher Cruise, Johneller, Charles Prather and Henry Throck appointed Justices of the Peace for Washington County Court and also to John Hull, Henry Schnebely, John Barnes, Joseph Chapline and Johneller appointed Judges of the Orphans Court for the same County. —

Ordered that the Young Commissary deliver to Capt John Courts Jones of the 7th Regt twenty Gallons of Rum and fifty eight pounds of Sugar - Genl Smallwood twelve Gallons of Rum and fifty seven pounds of Sugar and also to Lieut William Freeman Rodent of the 8th Regt twenty Gallons of Rum and eighty pounds of Sugar the deficiency of Stores due them for the Year 1700. —

That the W.S. Treasurer pay to Henry York one hundred pounds of the new Emifion for repairing Muskets on Account. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Isaac Jones of the first Regiment one Blanket —

Wednesday 31. January 1701.

Ordered That the Western Shore Treasurer pay to Captam John New and fifty pounds of the new Emifion inlieu of two thousand pounds and also the further sum of four hundred and thirty eight pounds, fifteen shillings and four pence half pence of the same Emifion inlieu of nineteen thousand nine hundred and fifty pounds fifteen Shillings due him for amounts paid by the Audt. Genl. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Denwood twenty one pounds, seven shillings and eleven pence of the same Emifion inlieu of eight hundred and fifty five pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence, and also the further sum of thirty two pounds, three shillings and eight pence inlieu of one thousand four hundred and seven pounds, seven shillings and six pence due him per Account paid by the Audt. Genl. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Munro Twenty five pounds of the same Emifion and two hundred pounds Continental on Account. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. William Richardson Eleven thousand eight hundred and thirty pounds, Balance due for Salt purchased of him in November last by this Board. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Richard Dorsey who was taken at the Battle of Camden in Augt. last fifty pounds of the new Emifion allowed by a Resolution of the Genl. Assembly paid his per Capit. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to William Roberts of the 1st Regt one pair of Shoes. — Enf. Basil Clements of the Regt. Extra one suit of Cloaths & Linen for two shirts. — Capt Richard Dorsey of the Maryland Artillery one suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts instead of the Articles for the past Year — and also to Lieut Capt Ricketts of the Artillery a suit of Cloaths & Linen for two shirts —

That the Young Commissary deliver to General Smallwood half a Bushel salt for the use of his family. — — — — — / Dated
