Commission issued to John Hull, Joseph Sprigg, Henry Schmebely, Joseph Chapline, John Barnes, Richard Davis, Andrew Bruce, Andrew Rench, William Yeates, Samuel Barret, Christopher Cruise, John Keller, Charles Prather and Henry Thyock appointed Justices of the Peace for Washington County Court and also to John Hull, Henry Schmebely, John Barnes, Joseph Chapline and John Keller appointed Judges of the Orphans Court for the same County. —

Ordered that the Young Commissary deliver to Capt John Courts Jones of the 7th Regim^t twenty Gallons of Rum and fifty eight pounds of Sugar — Gen^l Smallwood twelve Gallons of Rum and fifty seven pounds of Sugar and also to Lieut William Freeman Trovost of the 8th Regim^t twenty Gallons of Rum and eighty pounds of Sugar the deficiency of Stores due them for the Year 1700. —

That the W. S. Treasurer pay to Henry Yost one hundred pounds of the new Emission for repairing Muskets on Account.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Isaac Jones of the first Regiment one Blanket —

Ordered That the western Store Treasurer pay to Captain John Steward fifty pounds of the new Emission in lieu of two thousand pounds and also the further Sum of four hundred and ninety eight pounds, fifteen shillings and four pence half penny of the same Emission in lieu of nineteen thousand nine hundred and fifty pounds fifteen shillings due him per Accounts passed by the Aud^r. Gen^l. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Deewood twenty one pounds seven shillings and eleven pence of the same Emission in lieu of eight hundred and fifty five pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence, and also the further Sum of thirty five pounds, three shillings and eight pence in lieu of one thousand four hundred and seven pounds, seven shillings and six pence due him per Account passed by the Aud^r. Gen^l. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Munro Twenty five pounds of the same Emission and two hundred pounds Continental on Account —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. William Richardson Eleven thousand eight hundred and thirty pounds, Balance due for Salt purchased of him in November last by this Board. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Richard Dorsey who was taken at the Battle of Camden in Aug^r last fifty pounds of the new Emission allowed by a Resolution of the Gen^l. Assembly passed this 21st Instant.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to William Roberts of the 1st Regim^t one pair of Shoes. — En^l Basil Clements of the Reg^t. Extra one Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts. — Capt Richard Dorsey of the Regim^t. Artillery one Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts in part of the Article for the past Year — and also to Lieut Arch^d Richards of the Artillery a Suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts.

That the Young Commissary deliver to General Smallwood half a Bushel Salt for the use of his Family — — | Ordered
