Thursday 1st February 1701.

Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to Lieut John Howe
ten pounds, seven shillings and one penny half penny of the new Emifion value
of four hundred and fourteen pounds, five shillings and two pence passed by the D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Thomas five pounds, ten
shillings and seven pence half penny of the same Emifion value of Two hundred
and twenty one pounds, five shillings, and two pence passed by the D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Isaac Rawlings of the Artillery

That the said Treasurer pay to Job. Oriah Forest, nine thou-
-sand, nine hundred and fifty eight pounds, six shillings and eight pence and
also three hundred and eight pounds, nine shillings of the new Emifion out.

That the Armourer receive of Lieut Luckett three Chests of
Arms and one Keg of Flints. —

That the said Armourer receive of Capt Philemon Warfields
four Barrels of Cannon powder and four Kegs of Musket Ditto. —

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Lieut Isaac Rawlings
fifteen Gallons of Rum and forty eight pounds of sugar due him to the 1st Army last.

That the Public Records be immediately packed up with care
and removed by land to Elk ridge landing, there kept safe by Mr. Thomas
Hodgkin and this Board hereby engage to make the said Mr. Hodgkin a
reasonable satisfaction for his care of the Records and for the extraordinary
expense he must necessarily incur in removing his Family to the place of
Deposit. —
