

Subb Fowler appointed Messenger to the Governor and Council in the room of Robert Smith deceased. —

Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> February 1781.

Ordered that John Bullen Esq. Quarter Master furnish C<sup>o</sup> H<sup>o</sup> Hodgkin with two or more Waggon, Teams and Drivers immediately to remove the public Records that the Acting Commissary deliver to Doct. Murray fourteen pounds Salt petre to be accounted for —

That the western shore Treasurer pay to John Dorsey Esq. two hundred and forty eight pounds, five Shillings and six pence of the new Emission on Account.

That John Bullen Esq. Quarter Master deliver to Lieut Lockett a public Horse. —

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> February 1781. —

Ordered That the Acting Commissary deliver to Capt Nathaniel Shepherd employed in removing the Cargo of the Nautilus and Cato to Baltimore one Gallon of Rum. — Capt Samuel McPherson of the 1<sup>st</sup> Regimt. nineteen and a half gallons of Rum and forty eight pounds of Sugar — Capt William Bruce of the same Regimt. eighteen gallons of Rum and forty eight pounds of sugar and also to Ensign Henry Clements of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regimt. six gallons of Rum and twenty four pounds of Sugar due them for the year 1780. —

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Ensign Robert Katherston of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regimt. and Ensign Henry Clements of the same Regimt. each, Thirty pounds of the new Emission agreeable to a Resolution of the Genl. Assembly of the 30<sup>th</sup> Dec. last and also to the said Ensign Henry Clements six pounds, nineteen shillings and three pence of the same Emission in lieu of two hundred and seventy eight pounds, twelve shillings and six pence due him per Act. passed by the D. and. —

That the said Treasurer pay to His Excellency Thomas Sim Lee Esq. Three hundred and twelve pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission on Account. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt. William Bruce of the first Regimt. Cloth and Trimmings sufficient for a suit of Cloaths and Lincin for two shirts in part of the Articles for the present year and one and a quarter yards of Shalloon deficiency of 1780. —

In virtue of the "Act to Regulate Auctions" Thomas Yates is appointed Auctioneer for Baltimore County. — William Wise for Worcester County and John Denwood for Somerset County. —

Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February 1781.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to William Monson late a Soldier in the 7<sup>th</sup> Regimt. one suit of Cloaths, one shirt, one pair of shoes and one pair of Stockings on Account. —

That the western shore Treasurer pay to James Poulson two hundred thousand pounds of Tobacco including four percent for Cash to be paid over to James Day Esq. Deput. Paymaster of the Southern Army in lieu of Three hundred and twenty thousand Dollars for his order in favor of Peter Mallett Esquire, in virtue of a Resolution of Congress of June last
