Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> February 1781.

Dollars of the new Emision inlieu Twenty five pounds per Acct. paid by the Aud. Genl. —

That the Land Treasurer pay to the Honble John Rogers Esquire Three  
hundred and forty one pounds, fourteen shillings and two pence of the same Emision  
inlieu of thirteen thousand, six hundred and fifty eight pounds, six shillings and eight  
pence due him per Account paid by the Aud. Genl. —

That the Land Treasurer pay to Samuel P. Wright Esquire two hundred  
pounds of the same Emision on Account.

That the Land Treasurer pay to Charles Speke Esquire from Frederick  
Town one hundred pounds for the purpose of bearing his Expenses on his return.

That the Land Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson Junr. Four thousand  
and fifty two pounds, thirteen shillings and four pence due him for depreciation on his
