of Militia in Charles County. —

Zephaniah Turner Esquire appointed Auditor General, by the  
General Assembly in the room of Uriah Frost who resigned, after having first  
executed a Bond to the State as required by a Resolution of the General Assembly,  
and Thomas Gaspaway appointed Deputy Auditor, produced Certificates of their  
Qualification and the same filed. —

Ordered That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Simon Nicholls,  
seven thousand pounds to be delivered over to Thomas Richardson Commissary of  
Montgomery County on account. —

Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February 1701.

Ordered that the Commanding Officer at the Hospital receive therein  
Mary Darnall a soldiers wife of the 4<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> and that he draw rations  
and other necessaries which her present situation may require. —

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt. Robert Berry eighty three  
pounds, two shillings and six pence of the new Emission in lieu of three thousand, three  
hundred and twenty four pounds due him per Ac<sup>t</sup>: passed by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> February 1701.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Hannah May five  
Dollars of the new Emission in lieu seventy two pounds per Ac<sup>t</sup>: passed by the D. Aud<sup>r</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to the Hon<sup>ble</sup> John Roger Esquire three  
hundred and forty one pounds, fourteen shillings and two pence of the same Emission  
in lieu of thirteen thousand, six hundred and fifty eight pounds, six shillings and eight  
pence due him per account passed by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel J. Wright Esquire two hundred  
pounds of the same Emission on account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Spicket Esquire from Frederick  
Town one hundred pounds for the purpose of bearing his Expenses on his return.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson Junior four thousand  
and fifty two pounds, thirteen shillings and four pence due him for depreciation on his  
last years Salary per account passed by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> and also for the use of Robert  
Reith late a Surgeon to the Governor General one thousand three hundred & sixteen pounds  
thirteen shillings and four pence due him for the last years depreciation on his Salary per  
Ac<sup>t</sup>: passed by the Aud<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> and also three thousand one hundred and twenty two pounds  
due him for three months Salary to the first of February the time of his  
Disease. —
