

In virtue of the Resolution of the General Assembly of the 1st of May 1700 The Board have agreed to allow Mr Thomas Donellan fifty pounds of the new Emision per Month for his Services in receiving and Forwarding Provisions for the Army. —

Permission given to Col^o James Hamilton Warden of the Province & C^o Hamilton of East County to go into the City of New York. —

Thursday 22^d February 1701.

Commission issued to William Woodward just appointed Ensign of Capt Philmon Hauseley Company in the Seven Battalion of Militia in C^o New Hamptons County. —

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to John Randall fifteen thousand pounds for and also two hundred and thirty eight pounds one shilling of the new Emision in lieu of nine thousand five hundred & twenty two pounds one shilling and eight pence and fifty two pounds six shillings of the same Emision in lieu of two thousand four hundred and ninety two pounds due him per Account paid by the said Genl. —

Permission granted to Captain Legh Master to return to New Providence in the Sloop Experiment with such Prisoners as may be delivered him by Mr Daniel Hughes Commissary of Prisoners. —

Commission of Letters of Marque and Reprisal issued to George Buchanan Commander of the sloop John Lee one hundred and Seventy three Tons Gunton navigated by forty five men mounting twelve carriage guns belonging to Archibald Buchanan of Baltimore. —

The Governor and Council have this Day agreed with Mr Stephen Steward for three pieces of Broad Cloth vizt one piece white at 21 L 10 S one piece of Blue at 20 L and one piece Scarlet at 30 L per ell at four shillings & pence per Ell with Interest from this date at six percent the Money to be paid in May if possible. —

Friday 23^d February 1701.

Ordered That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Canall Esq twenty five pounds of the new Emision in lieu of an Order of the Just instant in his favor for three thousand pounds. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Enf. William Snoot of the 1st Regt. 12 pounds eight shillings and three pence of the same Emision in lieu of two hundred and fifty six pounds ten shillings due him per Account paid by the Dep^r Genl. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Nicholas Thackarell fifteen pounds twelve shillings and six pence of the same Emision in lieu of six hundred and twenty five pounds per Account paid by the said Genl. —

That the Commissary deliver to Enf. William Snoot eight Gallons of Rum and Thirty two pounds of Sugar due him to the 1st of January last.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Paul Drane a recruit for the 2nd Regt. one suit of Cloaths, one shirt & one pair of shoes. Benedict Reynolds of the 4th Regt. one suit of Cloaths, two shirts, one pair of Shoes, one pair of Stockings and one Blanket & to Will^t Harris discharged from the 3rd Regt. one Shirt, one pair of stockings & one pair of Shoes on the 1st of January last.
