

In virtue of the Resolution of the General Assembly of the 1st of May 1700 This Board have agreed to allowe C^{ll} Thomas Domellan fifty pounds of the new Emission per Month for his Services in receiving and forwarding Provisions for the Army. —

Permission given to M^{rs} Jane Hamilton Widow of the Reverend C^{ll} Hamilton of Gael. Scots, to go into the City of New York. —

Thursday 22^d February 1701.

Commission issued to William Woodward just appointed Ensign of Capt Philmond Mansfield's Company in the Seventh Battalion of Militia in C^{ll} Somerset County. —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Randall fifteen thousand pounds sent and also two hundred and thirty eight pounds one Shilling of the new Emission in lieu of nine thousand five hundred & twenty two pounds one Shilling and eight pence and fifty two pounds six Shillings of the same Emission in lieu of two thousand four hundred and ninety two pounds due him per Accounts passed by the C^{ll} Gen^l. —

Permission granted to Captain Legh Master to return to New Providence in the Sloop Experiment with such Prisoners as may be detained him by C^{ll} Daniel Hughes Commissary of Prisoners. —

Commission of Letters of Marque and Represal issued to George Buchanan Commander of the Ship Tom Lee one hundred and seventy three Tons burthen navigated by forty five men, mounting twelve Carriage Guns belonging to Archibald Buchanan of Baltimore. —

The Governor and Council have this Day agreed with M^r Stephen Steward for three pieces of Broad Cloth viz^t one piece white at 21 L. 10 S one piece of blue at 20 L and one piece Scarlet at 30 L per Ell at four Shillings per Ell per Linn with Interest from this date at six Shillings the Money to be paid in May if possible. —

Friday 23^d February 1701.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Canoll Esq^r seventy five pounds of the new Emission in lieu of an Order of the just instant in his favor for three thousand pounds. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Esq^r William Smoot of the 1st Regim^t six pounds, eight Shillings and three pence of the same Emission in lieu of two hundred and fifty six pounds, ten Shillings due him per Account passed by the Dep^y Aud^r. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Nicholas Thackerell fifteen pounds, twelve Shillings and six pence of the same Emission in lieu of six hundred and twenty six pounds per Account passed by the Aud^r Gen^l.

That the Commissary deliver to Esq^r William Smoot eight Gallons of Rum and thirty two pounds of Sugar due him to the 1st of January last.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Paul Dione a recruit for the 2^d Regim^t one Suit of Cloaths, one shirt & one pair of shoes, Benedict Reynolds of the 4th Regim^t one Suit of Cloaths, two Shirts, one pair of shoes, one pair of stockings and one Blanket & to Will^m Harris discharged from the 3^d Reg^t one Suit, one pair of stockings & one pair of shoes or all
