That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Denny four pounds, fifteen shillings and two pence of the same Emission in lieu of one hundred and ninety two pounds, seven shillings and six pence due him per Ac^t passed by the D. Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. David Lynn & Lloyd Beall of the 7th Regiment, each, four pounds, fifteen shillings and two pence of the same Emission due them per Accounts passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Brooke, fifteen pounds fifteen shillings and six pence of the same Emission due him per Ac^t passed. -
