Ordered that the western shore treasurer pay to New Redman, one pound seventeen shillings and six pence of the new Emision value of Twenty Five pounds due him per Account paid by the D<sup>r</sup> And -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Ignatius Boone of the 6th Regiment, three hundred and eighty two pounds, five shillings and two pence half pence of the same Emision value of sixteen thousand, three hundred and ten pounds, eighteen shillings and four pence due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> paid by the D<sup>r</sup> And -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Denny Four pounds, fifteen shillings and two pence of the same Emision value of one hundred and Ninety two pounds, Seven shillings and six pence due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> paid by the D<sup>r</sup> And -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. David Lynn & Lloyds Beall of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regt, each, four pounds, fifteen shillings and two pence of the same Emision due them per Accounts paid -

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Brooks, Fifteen pounds sixteen shillings and six pence of the same Emision due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> paid -

That the Young Commissary deliver to Lieut Robert Denny, Capt Lloyds Beall & Capt David Lynn of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regt, each, Six Gallons of Rum and twenty four pounds of Sugar and them to the 1<sup>st</sup> March next -

That John Butten Esq<sup>r</sup> Quarter Master deliver to Zachariah Dwall, twelve public Horses to be by him taken care of -

That the Armourer deliver to Thomas Rulland an Anchor belonging to the State to be returned -

The Governor and Comittee agree with John Dorsey and Company to transpo the flour saved from the stantiles to Baltimore Town, there to be examined & reported at the expence of the State and to deliver what may be good and Merchantable to John Dorsey and Company agreeable to the weight, in payment of so much flour purchased by the said Company for the cargo of the stantiles. -
