That the Young Commissary deliver to Lieut Nicholas Ricketts  
twenty Gallons of Rum and fifty nine pounds of Sugar due him to the 1<sup>st</sup> Int. -

In virtue of the Act of the General Assembly for the emitting  
"Bills of Credit to the value of five thousand four hundred pounds Sterling for the con-  
-venience of change and issuing them in exchange for the Bills of equal value now in  
"Circulation" passed October Session 1700, William Wilkins and Isaac M<sup>r</sup> Hard are appoint-  
-ed Supervisors of the press for superintending the printing of the said Bills and  
Frederick Green, Thomas Johnson jun<sup>r</sup>, John Callahan and Nicholas Harwood  
Signers thereof -
