Capt. Henry Hollingsworth appointed in Gaol and John Chalmers in Arm Room
joumies to give Provision of the meat kind not exceeding 5000 £ in each County for the
Detachment of Troops under the Command of the Marquis de la Fayette. —

Warrant issued directed to Stephen Steward Esq; to impress all Vessels on
West river and Herring Bay for the purpose of Transporting the above named
Detachment from the Head of Elk to Virginia —

Ordered that the following Commissary deliver to Samuel Howard,
James White and Godfrey Starbuck prisoners on their way to Boston, each, three
Days provisions - Lieut Col^t Ramsey twenty eight Gallons of Rum and one hundred
and twelve pounds of Sugar due him to the first of February inclusive - Col^t Hugh
Fenest thirty two pounds of Sugar due him to the month of Feby inclusive and
also to Capt Jonathan Sellman of the 4th Regt six Gallons of Rum and
twenty four pounds of Sugar due him to the 1st Instant —

That the Armourer deliver to Capt Joseph Middleton twelve
rounds of powder for Jewels. —

That the western Show Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty, eighteen
pounds, ten Shillings for the use of Richard Haft, seventeen pounds, thirteen shillings
and ten pence for the use of Captian Anthony Stock, six pounds, nine Shillings
and four pence half penny for the use of Charles Bayley, fifteen shillings and
ten pence half penny for the use of George Beall, one pound and three pence
for the use of John Yauff and fifteen pounds, seventeen shillings and six
pence of the new Empson due himself per Acc^t passed by the D^r And. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Col^t Nathaniel Ramsey
Twenty two pounds eight Shillings and ten pence of the same Empson for
Money per account passed by the Depy And. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Jonathan Sellman four
pounds, fifteen shillings and two pence of the same Empson due him for Money
per account passed by the Depy And. —

That the Commissary of stores deliver to Lieut Col^t Nath^e Ramsey
Cloth and Trimmings for a suit of Cloaths and Linen for Four Shirts for the
present year, and also to Capt David Lynn of the 7th Regt a suit of Cloaths
and Linen for two Shirts in part of the articles for the year 1701. —

On Considering the Charge against Thomas Wall and the Proof
adduced in Support thereof as well as the Defense made by the said Thomas Wall
to exculpate himself therefrom. Ordered that the said Thomas Wall leave Frederick
County in a reasonable time after his wife is delivered of the Child with which
she is now pregnant not exceeding Thirty Days, that in the mean time the
said Thomas Wall remain in Frederick Town and that the said Thomas Wall
do not return to Frederick County after his removal therefrom without the
leave of this Board first obtained. — Ordered that the said Thomas Wall
give Bond with one good Security in the penalty of Five Hundred pounds
to comply with the above order. —

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Col^t Adams fifty
pair of Shoes. —
